במלחמת העולם הראשונה התגורר בלונדון שבאנגליה ושם התנדב לגדוד העברי - הגדוד ה-38 של קלעי המלך - שהוקם במסגרת הצבא הבריטי. יחד עם הגדוד הגיע לארץ-ישראל במטרה להשתתף בכיבוש מידי התורכים. הוא לחם בהרי שכם ובמערכה על מעברות הירדן. ביום י"ג בכסלו תרע"ט (17.11.1918), נפטר בעת מילוי תפקידו.

זכרו הונצח ב"ספר ההוקרה ליהדות בריטניה 1914-1918" וב"בית הגדודים" באביחיל.
